It is also that time of year when your annual membership is up for renewal. This year we have added a third option for payment. 3 years for \$50. Get a \$10 discount and you don't have to worry about renewing for a while. (We will let you know when you'll need to re-up).

Make sure to visit the 2 calendars we have on the website. One is for DBA events while the other features local bands and out of town artists performing in the

area. We have a couple of good national acts coming through town along with the possibilities of some specialized workshops. Keep checking.

As many of you know there is a large group of pickers that visit the quaint town of Levelland, Texas each year to attend Camp Bluegrass at South Plains College. Each year we have 10 to 20 or more attend, we comprise about 15 to 20 percent of the total attendance. One of our objectives in the DBA is to keep this music alive and going strong by introducing and encouraging youth to play this genre of music. We have a scholarship fund for kids to attend camp. Some years we have 2 or 3, and unfortunately some years like this we have none. So a few things, plan on attending this camp if you are serious about improving your skills and looking for a great week of music and fun. Encourage youth you know to pick up an instrument and start coming to workshop. If you have grandkids, this is a great way to bond with them. I am also very excited to announce that I will be an instructor at this year's camp. I will be running a nightly slow jam for the beginners, teaching a jam class or two and be a floater for other instructors to work with beginner banjo and guitar students. I am very flattered that Alan Munde and Paula Carr asked me to be part of a great team of instructors and they are giving me an opportunity to expand my teaching methods to a wider national audience. I hope to see you at Camp Bluegrass July 14-19, 2019.

### MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL Save with our new 3-year renewal option!

Hi Bluegrass Fans,

It is the time of year when we ask our members to check the expiration date of their DBA memberships and renew their memberships if needed. In the Desert Bluegrass Association, we use a common expiration date. All expirations for the year occur on March 1st. The advantage of this approach is that we can focus on membership renewals once per year.

This year we are introducing a new option: you can renew for 3 years for only \$50. The 3 year option has real benefits. First you save \$10 which is a 17% reduction. Second you save time by only having to deal with renewals every 3 years. Third, we save time in processing renewals and reminding you to renew. So we all have more time to enjoy Bluegrass Music. That is a real win-win. Of course, you can still renew yearly for \$20 per year if you prefer.

So take a minute and see if you need to renew. If you received your newsletter electronically, check the e-mail for your expiration date. If you received this newsletter via postal mail, check the mailing label. If it says "expires 2-19" above your name, then your membership needs to be renewed. You may renew either by mail or from our website. To renew by mail simply fill out the form in the newsletter, enclose a check made out to DBA, then mail it to the address listed. If your information is current, you don't even need to fill out the form - just include the mailing address with your payment. To renew from the website, go to www.desertbluegrass.org, look for the "join DBA" area, click the "buy now" button and follow the instructions. Either way is simple and easy.

The DBA promotes and preserves Bluegrass Music in so many ways. Think of the workshops, the jams, the festival, the clinics, the website, the newsletter, the directory, the youth scholarships and more. All of this happens because of two things: First, the hard work of incredible volunteers and second, your memberships which provide needed funds. So renew today and keep supporting Bluegrass Music in Southern Arizona.




